

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City of Hollister has undertaken environmental review for the proposed update to the City of Hollister Parks Facility Master Plan. The City of Hollister invites all interested persons and agencies to comment on the proposed Project.

Project Location: City of Hollister and Sphere of Influence along Santa Ana Creek.

Project Description: The draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for an update to the Park Facility Master Plan. The plan includes an inventory of existing facilities, a needs assessment, and recommendations for park improvements, including two new parks and a trail.
